T5 fluorescent Lights

We have a very good price on lightweight low-energy T5 lights complete <u>with nano</u> <u>reflector</u>. Just plug in one strip or chain up to 8 on one cord to make a bank of lights. The ballast is integrated into the light strip. They are 54w with 6400 K natural light bulb. Sizes below. Price does not include taxes.

2 foot \$32.

3 foot \$35

4 foot \$38

In addition a limited supply of 3-foot bulbs without the nano reflector are available for \$29.00 plus tax. Also low output 28 watt T5 with fixture available in 4 foot for \$18 plus tax.

If you are interested in metal halide light with an electronic ballast a 400watt light with second generation ballast is \$160.
